PREFACE

The war and the danger of the COVID-19 pandemic lead to a deepening of the economic crisis in society. The specified global challenges became not only a test of the ability of state administration, economy and national security bodies to face significant challenges and threats, but also revealed significant problems in all spheres of society's life.
